### **General Conditions**

Severe beach erosion has caused extensive damage to the protective dunes and boardwalks at Conn and Humiston beaches. Water temperatures continue to drop as colder air descends on the region.

### **Areas of Concern**

Persistent east winds and heavy surf continue to generate rip currents, bring debris onto shore and push Man-O-War onto our beaches. It is strongly advised to swim on or near our guarded beaches.

### **Key**

Park Attendance: includes areas immediately north and south of each park

Preventative Actions: stopping potential incidents before they occur

Minor Medicals: a medical incident which is treated on-site by lifeguard/EMT personnel

Major Medicals: a medical incident that required Emergency Medical Services
